Institutional Code of Ethics for Mental Health and Substance Abuse Facilities



- » We are dedicated to the provision of services to those in need, and shall not discriminate on the basis of race, creed, color, gender, or sexual orientation.
- » We commit to the maintenance of **professional objectivity**, fairness, integrity, and compassion in the performance of our duties and in all our relationships with patient and families.
- » We demonstrate our competence through the pursuit of appropriate certification or licensure and seek always to better our skills through education and training.
- » We accept our duty as members of the community to adhere to accepted **community and civic standards**.
- » We shall in all aspects of our practice protect the confidentiality of our patients in accordance with applicable standards.
- » When asked to provide information to the public, we shall endeavor to ensure that the **information is accurate and not misleading.**

- » In all our duties, we are aware of the welfare of our patients and strive never to act in ways that may be contrary to the patient's best interests. We shall put the welfare of the patient above all other considerations.
- » In our dealings with other institutions, agencies, and professionals, we strive to maintain an attitude of respect, courtesy, and collegiality.
- » We accept responsibility for **promoting the welfare of our patients and reducing stigma** through community advocacy and education.
- » We shall **avoid intimate relationships** of any sort with current and former patients and families in accordance with professional standards and institutional policy.
- » We commit to reporting unlawful, unethical, or unprofessional conduct on the part of others to the appropriate supervisors for subsequent action.
